the path of life of Else Röhr

Else Röhr was born on 02. 08. 1907 in Magdeburg. As a young woman, she met the love of her life and got engaged. Her future husband was Jewish.

After the seizure of power by the national socialists he decided to leave Germany and he tried to persuade Else to leave together with him. However, she did not want to separate from her family and stayed in Magdeburg

Else suffered greatly from the failed relationship. She refused to eat; massive sleep disturbances led to a deterioration of her condition. From today's perspective was probably clinically depressed.

On 18 February 1936 she was admitted to the hospital Magdeburg-Sudenburg upon her own request. The doctors diagnosed her with childhood schizophrenia. This diagnosis, changed her life drastically...
